ESTABLISH RESIDENCY

To establish California residency for tuition purposes, you must:

- ✓ Be eligible to be a California resident
- ✓ Submit evidence of one year of physical residence in the state of California
- ✓ Submit evidence of intent to remain in California.
- ✓ Submit evidence of financial independence when seeking re-classification from nonresident status to resident status.
