 - Earned grades of "A" in two college-level courses (each at least 3 semester units) of the same foreign language or American Sign Language courses

- You are a native of a non-English speaking country and earned two "A" grades in college level English or English as a Second Language (ESL) courses (ESL 100, ENGL 100, etc.)
