Study Abroad (SA) Process steps:

- Attend Funding SA workshop
- Fill out FAFSA by priority deadline of March 2
- Meet with Financial aid advisor
- Apply to your chosen program
- Pay program deposit
- Apply for Scholarships
- Apply for passport
- Make personal wellness plan, consult with doctor, therapist,
- supporters etc. to make a plan, get meds, etc...
- Request any accommodations you may need by meeting with
- DSPS and the SA advisor

- Apply for Visas (If required)
- Complete <u>SA agreement</u> (https://www.cccd.edu/students/int-prgms-stdy-abroad.html) and submit it to the district by 5/20

- Purchase plane tickets
- Purchase Program <u>Medical Insurance</u> by program's deadline (<u>https://www.cccd.edu/students/int-prgms-stdy-abroad.html</u>)
- Pay enrollment/tuition fees when directed by SA advisor
- Pay balance of SA program fees according to program provider
- deadlines.
- Set up for time off work, set up a plan for any responsibilities you
- have, pets, car, apartment, elderly, children...
- Attend pre-departure orientation with the professor
- Take any placement tests needed for your language classes
- Set up transportation to/from the airports
- Pack (pack lightly!)
