Tell me about these scholarships?	<p>The Hazel Cubbon Greenleaf Scholarship is supported through the estate of Mrs. Greenleaf. Mrs. Greenleaf was a teacher and administrator in the Newport Beach schools for most of her adult life. The scholarship was established to provide funding for deserving students who have shown promise and improvement throughout their high school experience.</p> <p>The Waltmar Foundation was established by the late Walter & Marge Schmid with the goal of improving the lives of citizens throughout Orange County. The Waltmar Foundation Award provides scholarships for needy and worthy graduates of Orange County high schools who are continuing their education at Orange Coast College.</p>	<p>In 1975, a permanent fund was developed in order to provide a base for the OCC scholarship program called Scholarship 75. Over the years, students, faculty, staff, and community groups have contributed to this fund.</p> <p>Shirley Jane Brooke was a member of the Orange Coast College PE faculty from 1956 -- 1964. Ms. Brooke cared deeply about her profession and students. When she passed away in 2003 she left the bulk of her estate to the Orange Coast College Foundation to provide scholarships to deserving students.</p>
What are the requirements of these scholarships?	<p>The scholarship is offered to students who are graduating from one of the following school districts in the spring 2024:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Garden Grove Unified School District • Huntington Beach Unified School District • Newport Mesa-Unified School District • Santa Ana Unified School District • Tustin Unified School District 	<p>You must have earned at least a 2.5 grade point average in high school and be graduating in spring 2024.</p>
What are the amounts of these scholarships?	<p>If you are awarded this scholarship you will receive at least \$1,000 to continue your education at OCC.</p>	<p>If you are awarded this scholarship you will receive at least \$750 to continue your education at OCC.</p>
When can I apply?	<p>You may download your application www.orangecoastcollege.edu starting January 1, 2024</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Click "Admissions & Aid" ➤ Click "Scholarships" ➤ Click "OCC High School Scholarships" 	
What must I do to receive the scholarship?	<p>You must enroll in at least 12 units at Orange Coast College in the fall semester 2024. In addition, you are expected to write a Thank You letter to the donor organization.</p>	
When will I receive the scholarship?	<p>We will disburse your award once you provide the Scholarship Office with a copy of your semester enrollment receipt and copy of Thank You letter to the donor. Scholarship checks are mailed to your home address</p>	
Can I apply for this scholarship again?	<p>No, but OCC offers a General Scholarship for continuing and transferring students each year. Refer to the college web site - www.orangecoastcollege.com for more information.</p>

- Submit your **completed** application (application form, 2 letters of recommendation, and transcript from your high school), no later than May 17, 2024 by 5:00p.m. Applications should be received in the OCC Scholarship Office by this date and time. Late applications will not be considered.
