For which scholarships should I apply?	Apply for this scholarship if you have been a leader at your high school, church or youth program and/or you have a strong record of success in the classroom.	Apply for this scholarship if you are graduating from any Orange County High School in spring 2011
What are the requirements/ expectations of this scholarship?	<p>You must have earned at least a 2.50 grade point average in high school and be graduating in spring 2011</p> <p>As a recipient of the ASOCC Future Leaders Scholarship you are expected to become involved in one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Serve as a student government officer. Serve in one of the three branches of student government including Student Senate, Executive Board, Fiscal Affairs Council, Inter Club Council, and the College Life Committee. 2. Start a club or serve as a club officer. Serve as a club officer in one of our 50+ registered clubs or start your own. There are many clubs to meet a variety of social, cultural, political, career, recreational, and religious interests. 3. Serve as a student representative on a campus-wide committee. Work alongside college administrators, faculty and staff and serve as the student voice on a variety of campus-wide committees. 	You must have earned at least a 2.5 grade point average in high school and be graduating in spring 2011.

What must I do to receive the scholarship?	You must enroll in at least 12 units at Orange Coast College in the fall semester 2011. In addition, you are expected to follow through with one of the numbered items above.	
When will I receive the scholarship?	Once you provide the Scholarship Office with a copy of your semester enrollment receipt, a check will be ordered. Scholarship checks are mailed to your home address and typically are mailed on a weekly basis starting the third week of the fall semester.	
Can I apply for this scholarship again?	No, but OCC offers a General Scholarship for continuing and transferring students each year. Refer to the college web site - www.orangecoastcollege.com for more information.	
Due Date & Announcements	Completed scholarship applications for high school seniors are due in the Orange Coast College Scholarship Office by Thursday June 30, 2011 by 5:00p.m. Applications may also be mailed to Orange Coast College Scholarship Office – 2701 Fairview Road, Costa Mesa CA 92628. Applications must be received no later than Thursday June 30 . Incomplete or late applications <u>will not be</u> considered. Decisions will be forwarded to your High School Scholarship Coordinator or Counselor. Decisions are typically made mid-June.
