

THE STANLEY BEHRENS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

\$5,000 Scholarship awarded to an Orange County Community College Transfer Student who will be attending UC Irvine. **Deadline April 20, 2009**

Dear Administrator and Prospective UC Irvine Student,

The Stanley Behrens Foundation will award a conditionally renewable \$5,000 scholarship each year to an Orange County Community College Transfer Student who has demonstrated recognizable talents and who will be attending UC Irvine in the Fall of 2009. The award is contingent upon the applicant being **admitted** to UC Irvine. The Stanley Behrens Foundation will review the recipient's records at the end of each academic year in order to approve or deny the scholarship for each succeeding year for a possible total of two years.

The scholarship applicant will meet the following minimum eligibility requirements:

1. The successful candidate will have completed at least 60 units of credit with a GPA of 3.5 or above;
2. U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident;
3. Family income not exceeding approximately \$90,000 annually;
4. Student highly motivated to succeed;
5. Student involved in charity or community affairs;
6. While attending UCI, the student will:
 - a. Donate 90 hours each school year to a community service of her/his choice;
 - b. Maintain a grade point average of 3.0 or above;
 - c. Work for a salary no more than 12-15 hours per week while school is in session;
 - d. Attend a comprehensive career counseling session in her/his main field during the summer after the first year at UCI;
 - e. Meet the Foundation representatives 3-4 times per year to set goals and to obtain assistance in reaching goals.

The enclosed application and an official sealed transcript from all post secondary schools attended must be submitted to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships at UC Irvine. Upon review of the application, the Foundation may require verification of records and/or additional information. **The completed application must be received on or before April 20, 2009.** Please return the application and official transcripts to:
