For *off-campus* access to the library's electronic resources: log into MyOCC and click on the link titled "Periodicals and Electronic Resources."

For an encyclopedia and dictionary:

BRITANNICA ONLINE includes the *Britannica Encyclopedia*, as well as the *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary*, the *Britannica Book of the Year*, and 130,000 links to Web sites selected, rated, and reviewed by Britannica editors.

For electronic books:

E-BOOKS provides electronic full-text copies of published print materials, such as reference books, scholarly monographs, fiction and nonfiction books.

For general magazine and journal articles:

ACADEMIC ONEFILE is a comprehensive database containing mostly full-text periodical and reference titles covering a wide range of disciplines. It will limit a search to only scholarly (academic) journals or magazines or newspapers. Many articles are in PDF and HTML formats.

LEXIS-NEXIS ACADEMIC is a premier online source of local, national, and international news, business, legal, and government information, mostly full-text and mostly from 1985 to the present.

For newspaper articles:

LOS ANGELES TIMES provides access to full-text newspaper articles from 1985 to the present.

For opposing views, controversial or social issues:

OPPOSING VIEWPOINTS contains information on social issues. You may access viewpoint essays, full-text magazine and newspaper articles, statistics, primary documents, and links to websites.

CQ RESEARCHER and CQ GLOBAL RESEARCHER provide in-depth, non-biased analysis of the most current major and controversial issues of the day with complete summaries, bibliographies, and more. *CQ Researcher* covers national issues; *CQ Global Researcher* covers international issues.

SPECIALIZED ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

ACCESSSCIENCE provides full-text access to articles from *The McGraw-Hill Encyclopedia of Science & Technology*; "Research Updates" from *The McGraw-Hill Yearbooks of Science and Technology*; more than 12,000 illustrations; and the latest *Science News* headlines, biographies, and more.

BUSINESS & COMPANY RESOURCE CENTER includes company profiles and histories, rankings and statistics, financial ratios, business events and trends, case studies, and investment reports.

COUNTRYWATCH provides real-time news articles and country report information for each country of the world. It includes social issues, cultural information, maps, statistics, and more.

DISCOVERING COLLECTION has a variety of resources on history, biography, sociology, literature, and science

GALE LITERARY DATABASES contains information from *Contemporary Authors*, *Contemporary Literary Criticism Select*, and *Dictionary of Literary Biography*.

GALE PSYCHOLOGY COLLECTION provides psychology-related journal, magazine, and newspaper articles.

GREENFILE is a collection of scholarly, government, and general-interest titles concerning the environmental effects on individuals, corporations, and local-national government.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS RESOURCE CENTER provides full-text access to magazines, journals, newspapers, dictionaries, encyclopedias, directories, and web links to health and wellness topics.

HEALTH REFERENCE CENTER ACADEMIC provides full-text access to magazines and scholarly journal articles on health and wellness topics.

LEGALTRAC provides articles from major law reviews, legal magazines, bar association journals, international legal journals, and other law-related periodicals.

LITERATURE RESOURCE CENTER provides access to biographies, bibliographies, and critical analysis of authors from every age and literary discipline. Search by Author Name, Title, Genre, Literary Movement or Literary Themes, or combine criteria to create a custom search path.

OXFORD MUSIC ONLINE comprises the full text of *The New Grove Dictionary of Music*; *The Grove Dictionary of Opera*; and *The New Dictionary of Jazz*. In addition, it includes articles from periodicals; musical examples in sound as well as notated examples; and links to other relevant web sites.

PROFESSIONAL COLLECTION includes scholarly articles for educators and administrators.

PSYCINFO provides abstracts and citations (*not full-text*) of articles in scholarly psychological journals from 1887 to the present.

SCIENCE RESOURCE CENTER provides in-depth information for all science-related research needs. It includes full-text content from three core encyclopedias: *Gale Encyclopedia of Science*; *MacMillan Science Library*; and *U-X-L Encyclopedia of Science*, as well as reference titles; science periodicals; newspaper science sections; pictures, illustrations, audio clips, and video clips; and links to relevant web sites.
