

## **Disqualification of Financial Aid Awards**

Students who have not met the requirements of the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy will be disqualified for financial aid awards.

### Appeal Process

- Students who have been disqualified from receiving financial aid awards, may appeal the disqualification. The appeal approval/denial is based upon individual circumstances.
- Appeal forms are available in the Financial Aid Office and are mailed with the disqualification letter. The form must be completed and returned to the Financial Aid Office. Incomplete forms will not be reviewed.
- The Appeal Committee will review all student appeals individually and render a decision that is final. The Appeal Committee will meet weekly; all decisions will be forwarded to the student in writing.

### Probation

- Students may be placed on probation with conditions placed upon the student for the current award year.
- If the student meets the requirements of the probationary period, he/she will be removed from probation for the next award year.
- If the student does not meet the requirements of the probationary period, he/she will not be eligible for further financial aid awards.
