




## Setting Up Turnitin Assignment in Canvas

You will find the **Turnitin tool** within the **Assignment** tool.

Go to Canvas and in the course you want to add the Turnitin:

Click on  or if you are in the **Module** screen, click 



Add Item to Canvas Environment and Navigation

Add **Assignment** to Canvas Environment and Navigation

Select the assignment you want to associate with this module, or add an assignment by selecting "New Assignment".



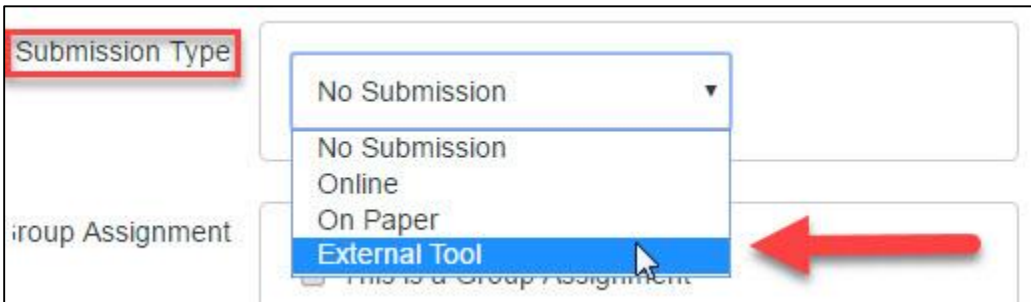

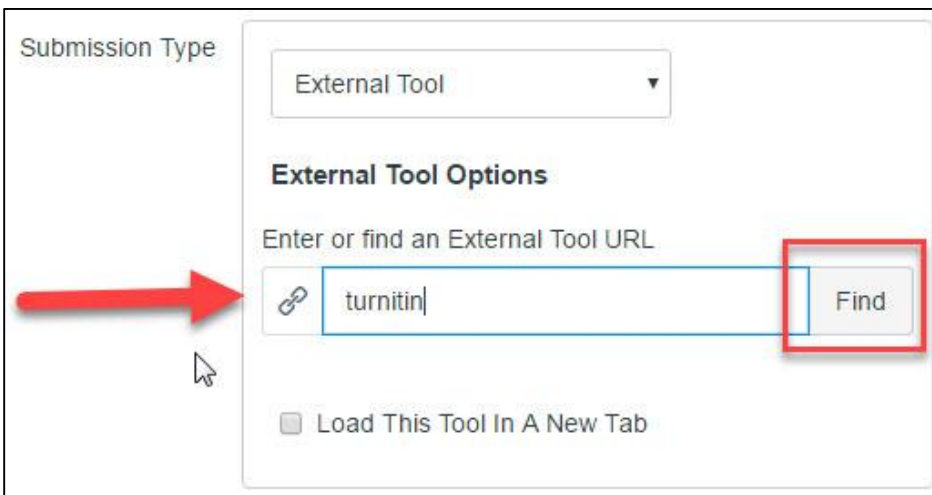


Using the scroll on the right, slide down to **Submission**

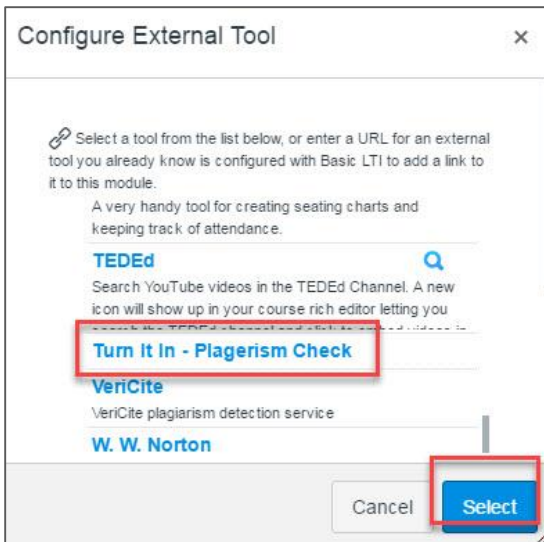


Click the drop-down menu and choose **External Tool**.

Click in the tool box and type **Turnitin**.

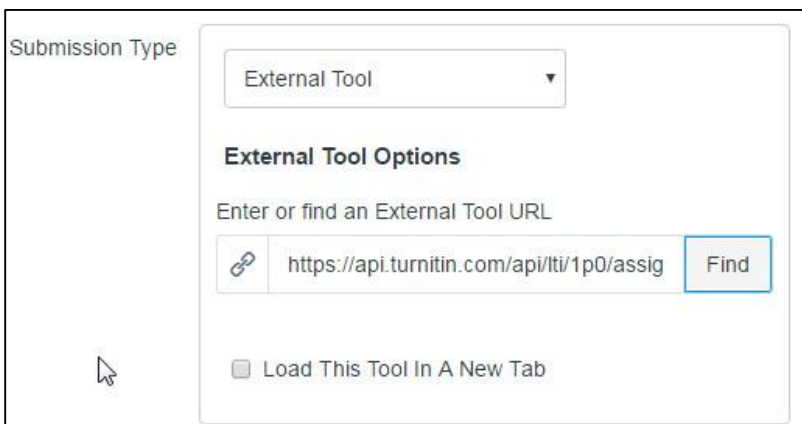


Click the **Find** button.



In the **Configure External Tool** box, locate *Turnitin – Plagiarism Check*

Click the **Select** button



**NOTE:** DO not make any changes in the link box.

If you want Turnitin to open in a new tab of the browser, be sure to click **Load This Tool in a New Tab**

Complete the rest of the Assignment settings as needed.

When done, click the **Save** or **Save & Publish** at the bottom.




The first time you load Turnitin, you will be prompted to complete the Agreement screen. Just click **“I Agree.”**
