




Setting Up VeriCite Plagiarism Tool in Canvas

You will find VeriCite tool within the Assignment tool.

Go to Canvas and in the course you want to add the VeriCite.

Click on  or if you are in the **Module** screen, click

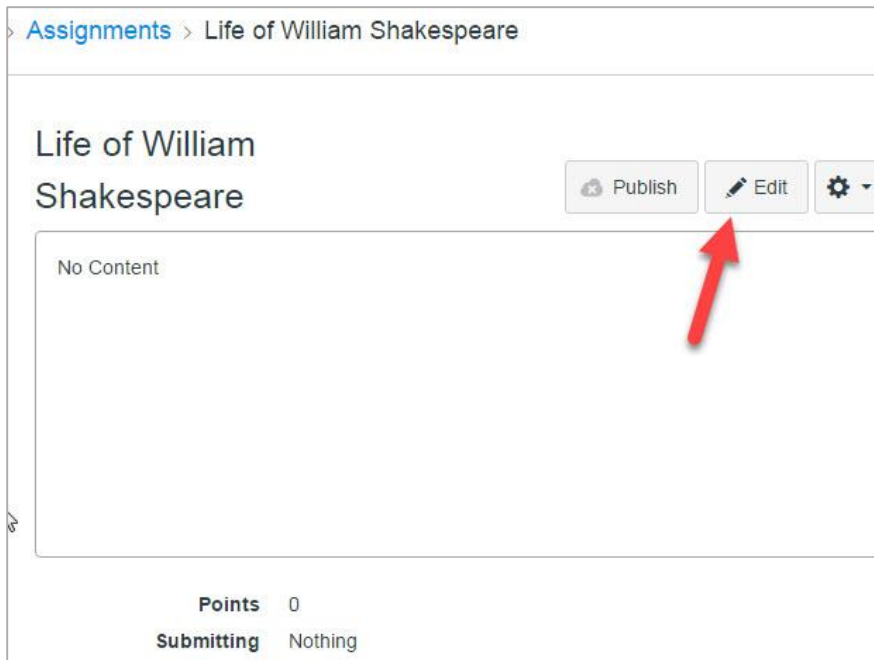

Enter a name for the Assignment (you can change it later)

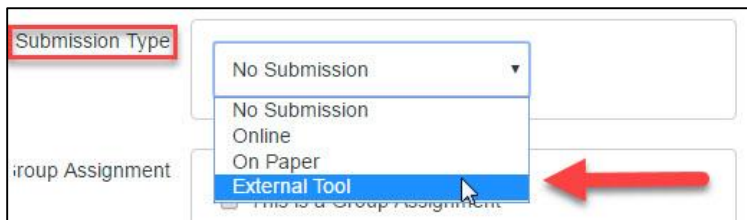
Click .

Click the newly created Assignment.

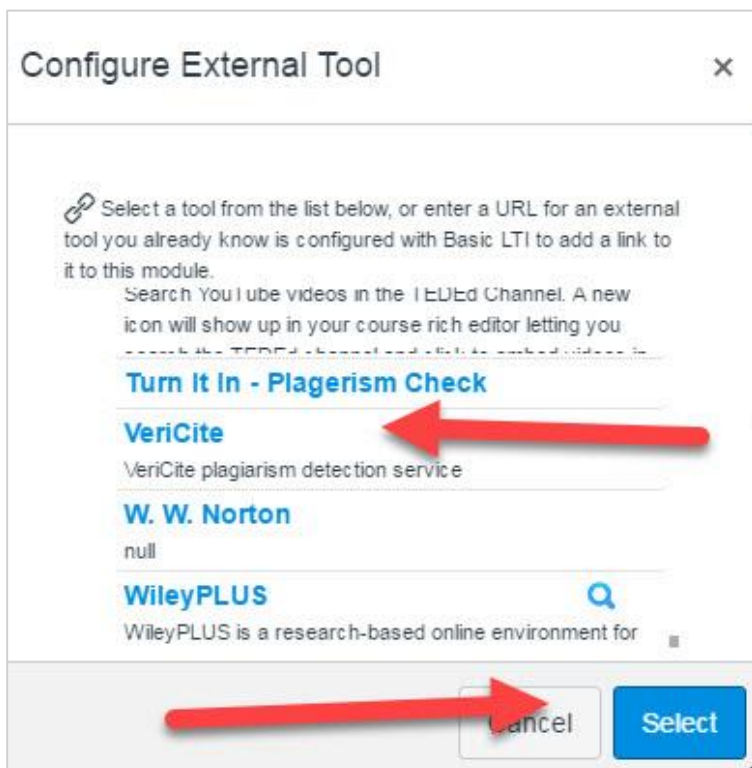


Click the **Edit** button.

Using the scroll on the right, slide down to **Submission**.




Click the drop-down menu and choose **External Tool**.



Double click the **Select** button and scroll down the list.

Locate **VeriCite**


NOTE: DO not make any changes in the link box.
