The Spring 2018 semester grades are now posted your grade point average (GPA) and progress (“W”s, “I”s and “NP”s) for that period was again unsatisfactory. You have now been on probation for at least three semesters and are therefore subject to [Dismissal](#). Please be aware that one of the requirements for OCC graduation and/or transfer to a four-year college or university is a cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.0.

Due to grade posting timelines, you were permitted to enroll for the summer and fall semesters. However, a registration hold has been placed on your account and you will need to Appeal for Dismissal to remove the hold. The appeal process is outlined below:
