## **ACADEMIC STANDING:** ***Disqualification – Academic & Progress***

The Spring 2018 semester grades are now posted and your grade point average (GPA) and progress (“W”s, “I”s, “NP”s) for that period was again unsatisfactory. You have now been on probation for at least two semesters and have therefore been placed on [Disqualification](#). Please be aware that one of the requirements for OCC graduation and/or transfer to a four-year college or university is a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.0.

Due to grade posting timelines for Spring 2018, you were permitted to enroll for the summer and fall semesters. However, **a registration hold has been placed on your account** and you will need to Petition for Reinstatement to remove the hold. In order to petition for reinstatement please follow the steps outlined below:

### **Next Steps:**

1. Schedule a [Disqualification Appointment](#) with a counselor to complete the Petition for Reinstatement
2. AIM for “C”s or better in your next semester classes and try to avoid dropping classes with a “W”
