# CSU Transfer Admission Requirements

- 60 CSU transferable units
- 2.0 minimum\* GPA (2.4 GPA for non-residents)
- Golden Four completed with a “C” or better:
  - Written Communication
  - Oral Communication
  - Critical Thinking
  - Transfer-level Mathematics
- 30 semester GE units
  - \* Minimum is not competitive at most campuses

## Spring 2018 Applicants:

CSUF: Golden Four courses completed no later than the end of the Summer 2017

CSULB: Golden Four courses completed no later than the end of the Summer 2017

\*ADT – Golden Four courses completed no later than the end of Fall 2017

# ADT: HOW DOES IT WORK?



☐ Need 120 units to earn a Bachelors degree

☐ 60 of those units are completed at the CCC

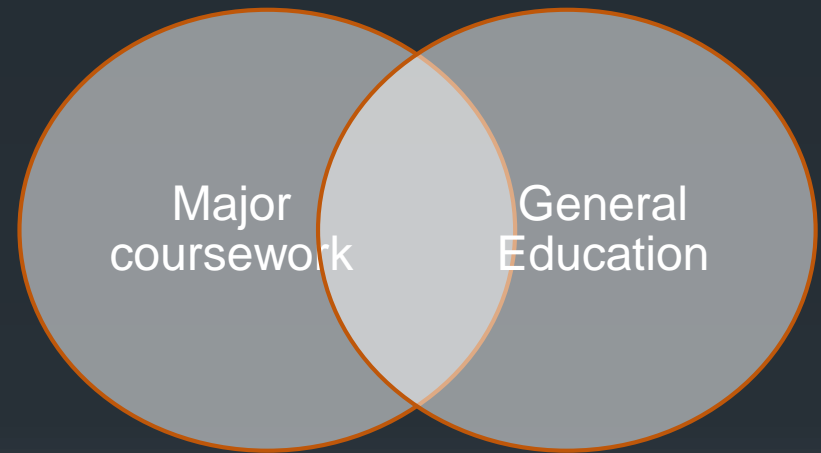

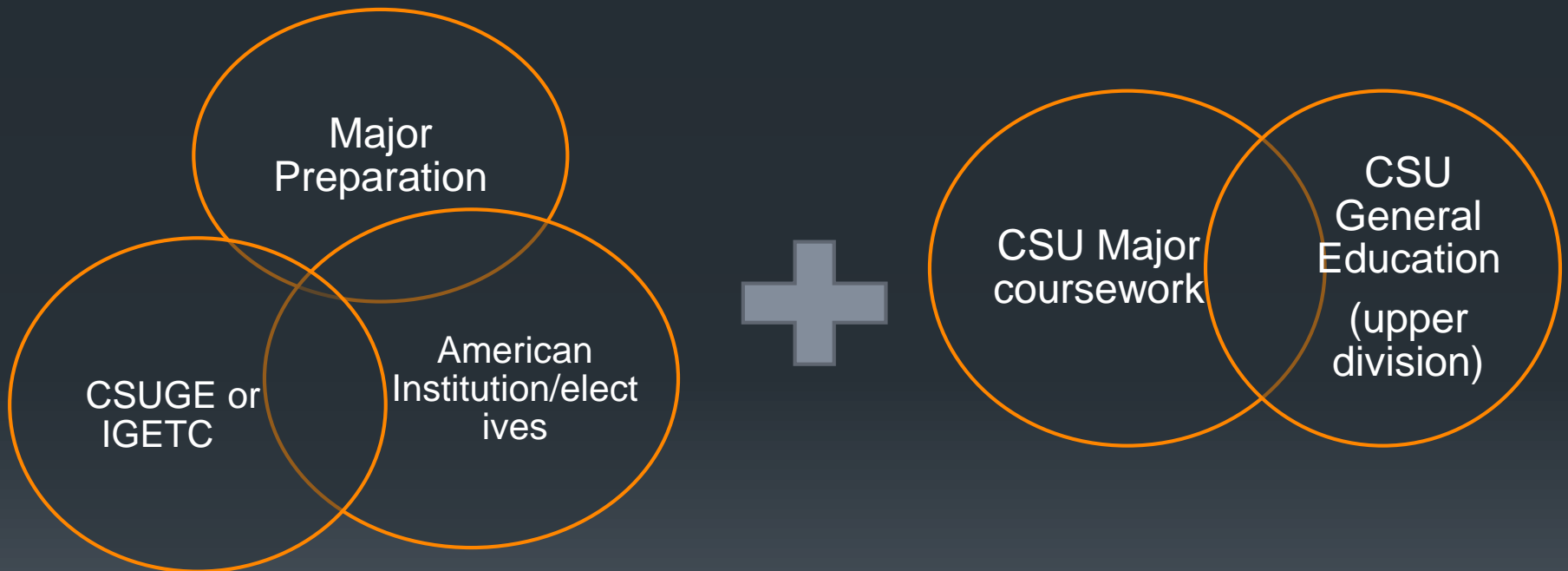

# ADT: How does it work?



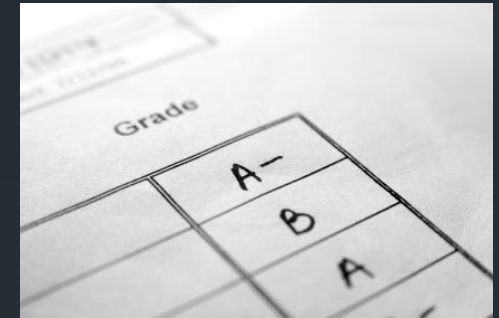
60 + 60 units=

# Electronic Verification of ADT for CSU

- Check DegreeWorks via MyOCC for Program of Study
- Complete Graduation Petition online or in-person
  - Submit, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Watson Hall
- OCC must have all Official Transcripts on file
  - Attended a college outside of Coast District (GWC, CCC)
  - AP Scores, High School Transcripts
    - 6 weeks to be evaluated, plan ahead!
- Apply by **Friday, October 20, 2017!!**
- Keep in mind CSU portal will not update for at least 2 weeks!
  - Be patient

# Final Transcripts & General Education Certification



- CSU will require transcripts by specific deadline
  - Follow request immediately
- Keep in mind grades for current semester are available 5 weeks after last day of term
- Pre-order transcript, mark your request “after final grades are posted”
  - Once grades are in system, request will be processed
- When requesting transcripts, mark the CSU GE Breadth or IGETC Certification box on transcript request form to request GE Certification



# Final Transcripts & General Education Certification

- Send official transcripts from every college & university attended, including GWC and CCC to CSU you are attending
- Submit official AP and/or IB scores





# Supplemental Applications

- Some CSU campuses require an online supplemental application. Some majors have separate supplemental application requirements and deadlines.
- Complete supplemental applications by deadlines provided by each CSU campus.



## Once Accepted

- Student will be required to submit a Statement of Intent to Register/Enroll (SIR/SIE) with deposit
  - Failure to do by deadline can result in acceptance being rescinded



# Notification of ADT Not Considered

- This does **NOT** mean you have been denied admission
- Reasons:
  - Student did not apply to a major that was deemed “similar”
    - Check <http://www.adegreewithaguarantee.com/>
  - Student will not complete ADT by deadline
    - In either case, the applicant will now be considered in the general pool without ADT benefits
