*You may apply for Full/Permanent Membership if you meet ALL of the following requirements:*

- Completed at least 12 units of college-level coursework, excluding qualifying foreign language/ESL/American Sign Language courses with a minimum cum GPA OF 3.0 **AND**
  - Earned grades of "A" in two college-level courses (each at least 3 semester units) of the same foreign language or American Sign Language courses
- OR**
- You are a native of a non-English speaking country and earned two "A" grades in college level English or English as a Second Language (ESL) courses (ESL 199, ENGL 100, etc.)

**One-time Full/Permanent Membership: \$60.00**

**Advancement to Full/Permanent Membership from Associate: \$30.00**

#### Criteria for Associate Membership (CHAPTER LEVEL ONLY):

- Any student who has met part, but not all, of the requirements for Full/Permanent Membership and has expressed an interest in eventually becoming a Full/Permanent Member may apply. Upon completion of all the requirements, the Associate Member shall be eligible for Permanent Membership

**Associate Membership fee: \$30.00**
