

Orange Coast College — UC TAG Checklist

- Attend an in-person or online workshop at Orange Coast College Transfer Center.
- Create an account with UC Transfer Admission Planner. <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/transfer/transfer-admission-planner/index.html>. Enter all college coursework. Please include AP and IB scores as well. Use transcripts to enter all information.
- Determine which campus you will apply to as your TAG campus. If you have any questions or concerns please visit the OCC Transfer Center during walk in hours. If you would like to make an appointment to meet with the OCC TAG counselor, please make sure you have completed an in person or online workshop.
- Students who choose UCSC or UCD as their TAG campus will need to make an appointment to meet with the OCC TAG counselor in order to verify their TAG application prior to submission. (Appointments can be made after attending a TAG workshop-online or in person)
- Submit TAG application beginning September 1-30, 2018 for Fall 2019.
- After submission of your TAG application in September, you will need to submit the main UC application November 1-30, 2018. This includes a personal insight questions as well.
- All TAG applicants will also need to submit fall grades and update spring courses online.
- Once students are admitted as TAG they must maintain all requirements in order to keep their TAG admission through the end of Spring 2019.
